Adult Class: Annita reports that the class schedule for 2024 is complete except for November and December. Annita said that she would like to teach a porch leaning sign class for November and Dona agreed to create a Christmas theme gnome painting for December.

Kids Class: Mary confirmed that Cristi is teaching cardboard masks kids class this weekend. Anniita will deliver remaining cardboard to recycle bin after completing of class. Mary shared that windchimes class would be a class that she could teach if needed.

New Business:

Summer Camp: The subject was brought up the we need to start planning for Kids Art Camp. Dona will talk to Royal about his availability to teach.

Mary recommended a refresh of our Angel Wings, the color is starting to fade. It was also recommended that the glider out front get a fresh coat of paint. The group all agreed. Mary and Annita will work together to produce new business cards with studio hours on it. .
