### Minutes

President Annita Wilson called the meeting to order at 6:03 p.m. with 7 members present.

Barbara Moore moved that the previous meeting's minutes (having been read online) be approved. Cyndie Romero seconded the motion. Motion approved.

Treasurer Polly Moore reported a bank balance of \$7235.72 (see attached for further transactions).

Cyndie Romero stated there was nothing to report as far as the gallery was concerned.

Polly Moore reported that \$2180 in grants was received by the alliance which should cover the costs of the summer art camp. The Wagoner paper is to print an ad for the camp.

Polly also reported that 'Cork & Canvas' classes have been scheduled through the year. New rules were discussed and it was decided that

1. Must be a minimum of 5 paid class participants.
2. No refunds or transfers of class fees.

Mary Rowe reported on the 'Pastel On Main' event (see attached).

Nancy Hurley suggested that Alliance allow ladies groups be allowed to meet in our building and possibly our members could attend to do a 'trunk' show. She stated that she and Carolyn Cooper would be in charge of that. She also suggested a 'Cork & Canvas' for the teachers to paint a banner to be placed in their school rooms.
