





Paint Like Picasso June 13th		<p>Students will get an intro to Picasso's work and we will talk about how children inspired his movement to abstraction in art. We will play a version of the Roll-a-Picasso Portrait Game and paint our composition.</p>
Georgia O'Keefe Cow Skull June 14th		<p>Students will start with a pre drawn layout of the skull and bands that they will transfer to canvas. A Roll-An-O'Keefe game similar to the Picasso is available for this piece, incorporating southwestern patterned elements. Students will be introduced to the application of acrylic paint, its use and limitations, etc.</p>
Van Gogh Inspired Paper Mosaic/Collage Flower Art June 15th		<p>Use pre-drawn layouts of sunflowers, lotuses, and other flowers that will be decorated with colored paper, tissue, decorative paper, magazine print, etc.* to make a beautiful floral design.</p>
Dream Catchers with Linda Ghaziosharif June 16th		<p>Instructor will show students how to make dreamcatchers.</p>
Chalk Art Mural (Outside) June 17th		<p>For this assignment (weather permitting) we will work outside on a large format chalk mural. This will be a group exercise and students will get to vote during the week on the design they want to complete.</p>

Warhol inspired Nature Pop Art

June 13th



Warhol inspired pop art exploring nature. Instructor will show the students how to trace an image and reduce it by hand to a few values. Students will have the option of doing their own value drawing or select from some pre-drawn images. They will transfer them to canvas and paint the image in vivid watercolors.

Paper Collage Art (2 days)

June 14th & 15th



Instructor will show students how collage art came about and how they can use various paper-based or other media as a means of applying color, texture, and visual interest to their designs.

Introduction to Still Life

June 16th



Teacher will introduce students to the composition genre of still life. Students will have the opportunity to make a still life in the style of Roy Lichtenstein's pop art.

Sharpie & Traditional Tie Die

June 17th



Students will have the opportunity to make their own tie-dye shirt designs & experiment with sharpie/alcohol based "tie dye" designs
