The meeting was called to order by President, Annita Wilson, at 6:00 pm with 9 members present.

Gallery manager, Cyndie Romero, reported that the gallery would be changed January 12. It was stated that artists should bring in no more than 3 or 4 paintings. Cyndie reported that the scratchboard and tree classes were both full.

Mary Rowe reported on the ART FAIR and needs to determine a date. She asked for ideas on how to up-scale the fair and bring in more artists and school clubs. It was suggested that it be called the "Wagoner Main Street Art Fair".

Mary Rowe donated \$200 for the January 23 children's art class being taught by Carolyn Cooper.

Annita said she would talk to the Chamber of Commerce about a membership ?swap?.

Polly and Cyndie proposed that the Alliance adopt a lay-away plan for customers that want to purchase artwork from the gallery.
